| 12 | (1)(a) As a convenience to the voter, the supervisor of |
| 13 | elections shall allow an elector to vote early in the main or |
| 14 | branch office of the supervisor. The supervisor shall mark, code, |
| 15 | indicate on, or otherwise track the voter's precinct for each |
| 16 | early voted ballot. In order for a branch office to be used for |
| 17 | early voting, it shall be a permanent facility of the supervisor |
| 18 | and shall have been designated and used as such for at least 1 |
| 19 | year prior to the election. The supervisor may also designate any |
| 20 | city hall, public community college facility, or permanent public |
| 21 | library facility as early voting sites; however, if so |
| 22 | designated, the sites must be geographically located so as to |
| 23 | provide all voters in the county an equal opportunity to cast a |
| 24 | ballot, insofar as is practicable. The results or tabulation of |
| 25 | votes cast during early voting may not be made before the close |
