- (a) Any person who desires to be certified or recertified as a 911 emergency dispatcher may apply to the department under oath on forms provided by the department. The department shall establish by rule educational and training criteria for the certification and recertification of 911 emergency dispatchers.
- (b) The department shall determine whether the applicant meets the requirements specified in this section and in rules of the department and shall issue a certificate to any person who meets such requirements. Such requirements must include, but need not be limited to, the following:

- 1. Completion of an appropriate 911 emergency dispatcher training program that is equivalent to the most recently approved emergency dispatcher course of the Department of Education and consists of not less than 208 hours;
- 2. Completion and documentation of at least 2 years of supervised full-time employment as a 911 emergency dispatcher since January 1, 2002;
- 3. Certification under oath that the applicant is not addicted to alcohol or any controlled substance;
- 4. Certification under oath that the applicant is free from any physical or mental defect or disease that might impair the applicant's ability to perform his or her duties;
- 5. Submission of the application fee prescribed in subsection (3); and
- Submission of a completed application to the department which indicates compliance with subparagraphs 1., 2., 3., and 4.
- The department shall establish by rule a procedure for the biennial renewal certification of 911 emergency dispatchers.
- (d) Each 911 emergency dispatcher certificate expires automatically if not renewed at the end of the 2-year period and may be renewed if the holder
