As used in this section, the term "cellular 17 18 telephone" has the same meaning as in s. 817.4821, Florida 19 Statutes. 20 This section does not prohibit the use of a cellular (2) telephone for safety or law enforcement purposes if the use is 21 approved by the Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles. 22 A violation of this section is a noncriminal traffic 23 (3) 24 infraction, punishable as a nonmoving violation as provided in 25 chapter 318, Florida Statutes. However, this section may be enforced by a state or local law enforcement agency only as a 26 27 secondary action when the operator of a motor vehicle has been detained for a suspected violation of chapter 316, chapter 320, 28
