An act relating to criminal history information; amending s. 943.053, F.S.; clarifying the purposes for which the fees collected from the private sector or noncriminal justice agencies to acquire criminal history information may be applied; increasing the amount of the fee charged per record for criminal history information; providing an effective date.

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Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

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Section 1. Subsection (3) of section 943.053, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

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943.053 Dissemination of criminal justice information; fees.--

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Program from intrastate sources shall be available on a priority basis to criminal justice agencies for criminal justice purposes free of charge. After providing the program with all known

centralized, automated database, including personnel, technology, and infrastructure expenses. Any access to criminal history information by the private sector or noncriminal justice agencies as provided in this subsection shall be assessed without regard to the quantity or category of criminal history record information requested. Fees may be waived or reduced by the executive director of the Department of Law Enforcement for good cause shown.

(b) The fee per record for criminal history information provided pursuant to this subsection is \$25 \$23 per name submitted, except that the fee for vendors of the Department of Children and Family Services, the Department of Juvenile Justice, and the Department of Elderly Affairs shall be \$8 for each name submitted; the fee for a state criminal history provided for application processing as required by law to be performed by the Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services shall be \$15 for each name submitted; and the fee for requests under the National Child Protection Act shall be \$18 for each volunteer name submitted. The state offices of the Public Defender shall not be assessed a fee for Florida criminal history information or wanted person information.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2008.
