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Section 10. Paragraph (a) of subsection (1) of section 409.91211, Florida Statutes, as amended by chapter 2007-331, Laws of Florida, is amended to read:

409.91211 Medicaid managed care pilot program.--

(1) (a) The agency is authorized to seek and implement 10 experimental, pilot, or demonstration project waivers, pursuant 11 12 to s. 1115 of the Social Security Act, to create a statewide initiative to provide for a more efficient and effective service 13 14 delivery system that enhances quality of care and client outcomes 15 in the Florida Medicaid program pursuant to this section. Phase one of the demonstration shall be implemented in two geographic 16 areas. One demonstration site shall include only Broward County. 17

A second demonstration site shall initially include Duval County 18 and shall be expanded to include Baker, Clay, and Nassau Counties 19 20 within 1 year after the Duval County program becomes operational. Persons with developmental disabilities as defined by s. 21 22 393.063(9), children found to be dependent pursuant to s. 23 39.01(14), adults with serious mental illness as defined in s. 1912 (c) of the Public Health Service Act, children with special 24 25 health care needs as defined by s. 391.021(2) or s. 391.029, and recipients who meet the institutional or "ICP" level of care 26 27 required for Medicaid nursing home care or enrollment in a 28 Medicaid home-based or community-based waiver and dual eligible 29 individuals are excluded from mandatory enrollment in the pilot 30 program until the service delivery systems described in paragraphs (3) (ee), (ff), (gg), and (hh) have been developed and 31 32 evaluated for a period of at least 1 year and until the Legislature expressly authorizes their mandatory enrollment.
