18 1001.42(16) and 1008.345. A majority of the members of each school advisory council must be persons who are not employed by 19 20 the school district. Each advisory council shall be composed of 21 the principal and an appropriately balanced number of teachers, 22 education support employees, students, parents, and other 23 business and community citizens who are representative of the 24 ethnic, racial, and economic community served by the school. 25 Career center and high school advisory councils shall include 26 students, and middle and junior high school advisory councils may 27 include students. School advisory councils of career centers and adult education centers are not required to include parents as 28 29 members. Council members representing teachers, education support 30 employees, students, and parents shall be elected by their respective peer groups at the school in a fair and equitable 31 32 manner as follows:

1. Teachers shall be elected by teachers.

34 2. Education support employees shall be elected by35 education support employees.

3. Students shall be elected by students.

37 38 4. Parents shall be elected by parents.

The district school board shall establish procedures for use by 39 schools in selecting business and community members that include 40 41 means of ensuring wide notice of vacancies and of taking input on 42 possible members from local business, chambers of commerce, community and civic organizations and groups, and the public at 43 large. The district school board shall review the membership 44 45 composition of each advisory council. If the district school board determines that the membership elected by the school is not 46 47 representative of the ethnic, racial, and economic community

served by the school, the district school board shall appoint 48 49 additional members to achieve proper representation. The commissioner shall determine if schools have maximized their 50 efforts to include on their advisory councils minority persons 51 52 and persons of lower socioeconomic status. Although schools are 53 strongly encouraged to establish school advisory councils, the 54 district school board of any school district that has a student population of 10,000 or fewer may establish a district advisory 55 56 council which shall include at least one duly elected teacher 57 from each school in the district. For the purposes of school advisory councils and district advisory councils, the term 58 59 "teacher" shall include classroom teachers, certified student 60 services personnel, and media specialists. For purposes of this paragraph, "education support employee" means any person employed 61 by a school who is not defined as instructional or administrative 62 personnel pursuant to s. 1012.01 and whose duties require 20 or 63 64 more hours in each normal working week. 65 66 (and renumber subsequent sections) 67 68 69 70 71 72 And the title is amended as follows: 73 Delete line 3 and insert: 74 75 providing definitions; amending s. 1001.452, F.S.; 76 revising provisions relating to membership of school 77 advisory councils; amending s. 1003.41, F.S.; Page 3 of 3
