(b) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the width requirements of this chapter do not apply to agricultural equipment and implements of husbandry used for agricultural purposes. Agricultural equipment and implements of husbandry used for agricultural purposes are authorized for the purpose of moving from one point of agricultural production to another, if such movement is performed during daylight hours within a radius of 50 miles from the point of origin thereof and no part of such movement is upon any highway designated as a part of the National System of Interstate and Defense Highways or any fully controlled access highway facility. Such vehicles shall be operated in

accordance with all safety requirements prescribed by law and rules of the Department of Transportation.

(c) (b) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, equipment not exceeding 136 inches in width and not capable of speeds exceeding 20 miles per hour which is used exclusively for harvesting forestry products is authorized for the purpose of transporting equipment from one point of harvest to another point of harvest, not to exceed 10 miles, by a person engaged in the harvesting of forestry products. Such vehicles must be operated during daylight hours only, in accordance with all safety requirements prescribed by s. 316.2295(5) and (6).

Section 2. Subsection (4) of section 316.535, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

316.535 Maximum weights.--

(4) With respect to the Interstate Highway System, in all cases in which it exceeds state law in effect on January 4, 1975, the overall gross weight on a group of two or more consecutive axles of a vehicle or combination of vehicles, including all enforcement tolerances, shall be as determined by the following formula:

W = 500 ((LN / (N-1)) + 12N + 36)

where W = the overall gross weight on any group of two or more consecutive axles to the nearest 500 pounds; L =the distance in feet between the extremes of any group of two or more consecutive axles; and N = the number of axles in the group under consideration. Such overall gross weight of any vehicle or combination of vehicles may not exceed 80,000 pounds, including all enforcement tolerances, except that, for a vehicle or



combination of vehicles moving agricultural or forestry products from the point of harvest to the first point of marketing or processing when no part of such movement is upon any highway designated as a part of the National System of Interstate and Defense Highways, the vehicle or combination of vehicles may not exceed an overall gross weight of 84,000 pounds, including all enforcement tolerances.
