An act relating to state parks; amending s. 258.014, F.S.; providing free admission to state parks on certain state

and federal holidays for qualified persons to honor those serving or having served in the United States Armed Forces; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Subsection (3) is added to section 258.014, Florida Statutes, to read:

258.014 Fees for use of state parks.--

admission fees for all active-duty military personnel, or the spouse or minor child of such person, having valid identification on the Memorial Day holiday and for all visitors on the Veterans Day holiday in honor of those who have served in the United States Armed Forces. The division is also encouraged to hold special events and take other actions appropriate to show the appreciation for those who have served our country in the Armed Forces.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2008.
