320.08056 Specialty license plates.--

The following license plate annual use fees shall be collected for the appropriate specialty license plates:

(mmm) Fraternal Order of Police license plate, \$25.

Section 28. Subsection (65) is added to section 320.08058, Florida Statutes, to read:

320.08058 Specialty license plates.--

- (65) FRATERNAL ORDER OF POLICE LICENSE PLATES. --
- (a) Notwithstanding s. 320.08053, the department and the Florida Fraternal Order of Police shall develop a Fraternal Order



of Police license plate as provided in this section. Fraternal Order of Police license plates must bear the colors and design approved by the department. The word "Florida" must appear at the top of the plate, and the words "Fraternal Order of Police" must appear at the bottom of the plate.

The requirements of s. 320.08053 must be met prior to the issuance of the plate. Thereafter, the license plate annual use fees shall be distributed to the Florida State Lodge Fraternal Order of Police Memorial Committee, Inc., a 501(c)(3) corporation, to fund programs involved in the honoring of law enforcement officers who have fallen in the line of duty and their families. Such funds may be used to provide maintenance of the memorial, scholarship programs for spouses and children of fallen officers, and transportation, food, counseling, and other direct administrative and program expenses. The funds may also be used as grants for expansion of programs for the Florida Fraternal Order of Police Law Enforcement Memorial. Florida State Lodge Fraternal Order of Police Memorial Committee, Inc., may retain all revenue from the annual use fees until all startup costs for developing and establishing the plate have been recovered. Thereafter, up to 10 percent of the annual use fee revenue may be used for promotion and marketing of the plate and as necessary for annual audit or compliance affidavit costs.
