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17 (8) (7) (a) If the head of the department determines that it is in the best interests of the public, the department may 18 19 combine the design and construction phases of a building, a major 20 bridge, a limited access facility, or a rail corridor project 21 into a single contract. Such contract is referred to as a design-22 build contract. The department shall advertise for bid a minimum of 25 percent of the construction contracts which add capacity in 23 24 the 5-year adopted work program as design-build contracts. 25 Design-build contracts may be advertised and awarded 26 notwithstanding the requirements of paragraph (3) (c). However, 27 construction activities may not begin on any portion of such 28 projects for which the department has not yet obtained title to 29 the necessary rights-of-way and easements for the construction of 30 that portion of the project has vested in the state or a local governmental entity and all railroad crossing and utility 31 agreements have been executed. Title to rights-of-way shall be 32 deemed to have vested in the state when the title has been 33 34 dedicated to the public or acquired by prescription. 35 (b) The department shall adopt by rule procedures for 36 administering design-build contracts. Such procedures shall include, but not be limited to: 37 1. Pregualification requirements. 38 39 2. Public announcement procedures. 40 3. Scope of service requirements. 41 4. Letters of interest requirements. Short-listing criteria and procedures. 42 5. 43 6. Bid proposal requirements. 7. Technical review committee. 44 45 8. Selection and award processes. 46 9. Stipend requirements.
