Upon making such initial 19 application, the applicant person applying therefor shall pay to 20 the department a fee of \$300 in addition to any other fees now 21 required by law; upon making a subsequent renewal application, 22 the applicant person applying therefor shall pay to the 23 department a fee of \$75 in addition to any other fees now required by law. Upon making an application for a change of 24 location, the person shall pay a fee of \$50 in addition to any 25 26 other fees now required by law. The department shall, in the case 27 of every application for initial licensure, verify whether certain facts set forth in the application are true. Each 28 29 applicant, general partner in the case of a partnership, or 30 corporate officer and director in the case of a corporate applicant, must file a set of fingerprints with the department 31 for the purpose of determining any prior criminal record or any 32 outstanding warrants. The department shall submit the 33 34 fingerprints to the Department of Law Enforcement for state 35 processing and forwarding to the Federal Bureau of Investigation 36 for federal processing. The actual cost of such state and federal 37 processing shall be borne by the applicant and is to be in addition to the fee for licensure. The department may issue a 38 39 license to an applicant pending the results of the fingerprint 40 investigation, which license is fully revocable if the department 41 subsequently determines that any facts set forth in the 42 application are not true or correctly represented.
