All public libraries are encouraged to adopt an 7 Internet safety education program, including the implementation 8 of a computer-based educational program, which has been endorsed 9 by a United States government-sanctioned law enforcement agency or other reputable organization and is designed for children and 10 11 adults. The purpose of the Internet safety education program is 12 to promote the use of prudent online deportment and broaden awareness of online sexual offenders and predators. The program 13 shall be interactive and age-appropriate. Each library shall 14 15 annually report to the division the annual number of users who 16 complete the education program. By April 1, 2009, the Division of 17 Library and Information Services of the Department of State shall
