(1) The Florida Center for Nursing Trust Fund, FLAIR number 64-2-283, within the Department of Health is 38 39 terminated. 40 (2) All current balances remaining in, and all revenues of, 41 the trust fund shall be transferred to the Grants and Donations 42 Trust Fund within the Department of Health, FLAIR number 64-2-43 339. 44 The Department of Health shall pay any outstanding (3) 45 debts and obligations of the terminated fund as soon as 46 practicable, and the Chief Financial Officer shall close out and 47 remove the terminated fund from the various state accounting 48 systems using generally accepted accounting principles concerning 49 warrants outstanding, assets, and liabilities. 50 Section 2. Section 20.435, Florida Statutes, is amended to 51 read: 52 20.435 Department of Health; trust funds.--53 (1) The following trust funds shall are hereby created, to 54 be administered by the Department of Health: 55 (1) (a) Administrative Trust Fund. 56 (a) 1. Funds to be credited to the trust fund shall consist 57 of regulatory fees such as those pertaining to the licensing, 58 permitting, and inspection of septic tanks, food hygiene, onsite

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59 sewage, Superfund compliance, solid waste management, tanning 60 facilities, mobile home and recreational vehicle park inspection, other departmental regulatory and health care programs, and 61 indirect earnings from grants. Funds shall be used for the 62 63 purpose of supporting the regulatory activities of the department 64 and for other such purposes as may be appropriate and shall be expended only pursuant to legislative appropriation or an 65 66 approved amendment to the department's operating budget pursuant 67 to the provisions of chapter 216.

74 (a) 1. Funds to be credited to the trust fund shall consist 75 of grants and funding from the Federal Government and funds from 76 the Medicaid program. Funds shall be used for the purposes of 77 providing health and support services to department clients, 78 supporting regulatory activities of the department, and funding 79 disease surveillance and for other such purposes as may be 80 appropriate and shall be expended only pursuant to legislative 81 appropriation or an approved amendment to the department's 82 operating budget pursuant to the provisions of chapter 216.

83 (b)^{2.} Notwithstanding the provisions of s. 216.301 and 84 pursuant to s. 216.351, any balance in the trust fund at the end 85 of any fiscal year shall remain in the trust fund at the end of 86 the year and shall be available for carrying out the purposes of 87 the trust fund.

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(3) (c) Grants and Donations Trust Fund.

89 (a) 1. Funds to be credited to the trust fund shall consist 90 of restricted contractual revenue from public or private sources such as receipts from Medicaid, funds from federal environmental 91 92 laws such as the Safe Drinking Water Act and the Superfund, funds 93 from other health and environmental programs, and funds from 94 private sources such as foundations. Funds shall be used for the 95 purpose of supporting the activities of the department and shall 96 be expended only pursuant to legislative appropriation or an 97 approved amendment to the department's operating budget pursuant to the provisions of chapter 216. 98

99 (b)2. Notwithstanding the provisions of s. 216.301 and 100 pursuant to s. 216.351, any balance in the trust fund at the end 101 of any fiscal year shall remain in the trust fund at the end of 102 the year and shall be available for carrying out the purposes of 103 the trust fund.

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(4) (d) Medical Quality Assurance Trust Fund.

105 (a) 1. Funds to be credited to the trust fund shall consist 106 of fees and fines related to the licensing of health care 107 professionals. Funds shall be used for the purpose of providing 108 administrative support for the regulation of health care 109 professionals and for other such purposes as may be appropriate 110 and shall be expended only pursuant to legislative appropriation 111 or an approved amendment to the department's operating budget 112 pursuant to the provisions of chapter 216.

113 (b)². Notwithstanding the provisions of s. 216.301 and 114 pursuant to s. 216.351, any balance in the trust fund at the end 115 of any fiscal year shall remain in the trust fund at the end of

Funds shall be used for the purpose of 122 providing health care services to department clients and for 123 other such purposes as may be appropriate and shall be expended 124 only pursuant to legislative appropriation or an approved 125 amendment to the department's operating budget pursuant to the 126 provisions of chapter 216.

Funds shall be used 135 for the purpose of providing health care and support services to 136 department clients and for other such purposes as may be 137 appropriate and shall be expended only pursuant to legislative 138 appropriation or an approved amendment to the department's 139 operating budget pursuant to the provisions of chapter 216.

Notwithstanding the provisions of s. 216.301 and 152 pursuant to s. 216.351, any unencumbered balance in the trust 153 fund at the end of any fiscal year and any encumbered balance 154 remaining undisbursed on <u>September 30</u> December 31 of the same 155 calendar year shall revert to the Department of Financial 156 Services Tobacco Settlement Clearing Trust Fund.

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(8) (h) Biomedical Research Trust Fund.

158 (a) 1. Funds to be credited to the trust fund shall consist 159 of funds deposited pursuant to s. 215.5601 and any other funds 160 appropriated by the Legislature. Funds shall be used for the 161 purposes of the James and Esther King Biomedical Research Program 162 and the William G. "Bill" Bankhead, Jr., and David Coley Cancer 163 Research Program as specified in ss. 215.5602, 288.955, and 164 381.922. The trust fund is exempt from the service charges 165 imposed by s. 215.20.

166 (b)². Notwithstanding the provisions of s. 216.301 and 167 pursuant to s. 216.351, any balance in the trust fund at the end 168 of any fiscal year shall remain in the trust fund at the end of 169 the year and shall be available for carrying out the purposes of 170 the trust fund. 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(9) (i) Welfare Transition Trust Fund.

The Welfare Transition Trust Fund is created within 183 the Department of Health for the purposes of receiving federal funds under the Temporary Assistance for Needy Families Program. 184 185 Trust fund moneys shall be used exclusively for the purpose of 186 providing services to individuals eligible for Temporary 187 Assistance for Needy Families pursuant to the requirements and 188 limitations of part A of Title IV of the Social Security Act, as 189 amended, or any other applicable federal requirement or 190 limitation. Funds credited to the trust fund consist of those 191 funds collected from the Temporary Assistance for Needy Families 192 Block Grant.
