The coverage provided by the fund under this 24 subparagraph shall be in addition to the claims-paying capacity as defined in subparagraph (c)1., but only with respect to those 25 26 insurers that select the additional coverage option and meet the 27 requirements of this subparagraph. The claims-paying capacity with respect to all other participating insurers and limited 28 29 apportionment companies that do not select the additional 30 coverage option shall be limited to their reimbursement premium's proportionate share of the actual claims-paying capacity 31 otherwise defined in subparagraph (c)1. and as provided for under 32 the terms of the reimbursement contract. Coverage provided in the 33 34 reimbursement contract will not be affected by the additional 35 premiums paid by participating insurers exercising the additional 36 coverage option allowed in this subparagraph.
