21	Section 2. Paragraph (c) of subsection (1) of section
22	322.135, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:
23	322.135 Driver's license agents
24	(1) The department may, upon application, authorize any or
25	all of the tax collectors in the several counties of the state,
26	subject to the requirements of law, in accordance with rules of
27	the department, to serve as its agent for the provision of
28	specified driver's license services.
