17	(a) The department shall develop a Horse Country license
18	plate as provided in this subsection. However, the requirements
19	of s. 320.08053 must be met prior to the issuance of the plate.
20	Horse Country license plates must bear the colors and design
21	approved by the department. The word "Florida" must appear at the
22	top of the plate, and the words "Horse Country" must appear at
23	the bottom of the plate.
24	(b) The license plate annual use fees shall be distributed
25	to PCMI Properties, Inc., to fund its activities, programs, and
26	projects within the state. Funds must be used in this state. PCMI
27	Properties, Inc., may retain all revenue from the annual use fees
28	until up to \$60,000 of its documented startup costs for
29	developing and establishing the plate have been recovered.
30	Thereafter, revenue from the annual use fees shall be used as
31	follows:
32	1. Up to 25 percent of the annual use fee revenue may be
33	used for promotion and marketing of the plate.
34	2. Funds may be used as necessary for annual audit or
35	compliance affidavit costs.
36	3. The remaining revenue shall be used for programs
37	involved in the rehabilitation of at-risk youth as directed by
38	the Board of Trustees of PCMI Properties, Inc. Such funds may be
39	used to provide educational materials, athletic equipment,
40	transportation, food, medical services, counseling, scholarships,
41	and other direct administrative and program expenses. The funds
42	may also be used as grants for expanding youth rehabilitation
43	programs in the state. Special consideration shall be given to
44	programs using horses and other livestock in efforts to redirect
45	at-risk youth.
