Such electronic sales shall 37 comply with the procedures provided in this chapter, except that 38 electronic proxy bidding shall be allowed and the clerk may 39 require bidders to advance sufficient funds to pay the deposit required by subsection (3). The clerk shall provide access to the 40 41 electronic sale by computer terminals that are open to the public 42 at a designated location, and shall accept an advance credit 43 proxy bid from the plaintiff of any amount up to the maximum 44 allowable credit bid of the plaintiff.
