Senate Amendment (with title amendment)

Delete everything after the enacting clause and insert:

Section 1. Subsection (8) is added to section 212.055, Florida Statutes, to read:

9 212.055 Discretionary sales surtaxes; legislative intent; authorization and use of proceeds. -- It is the legislative intent 10 that any authorization for imposition of a discretionary sales 11 12 surtax shall be published in the Florida Statutes as a subsection of this section, irrespective of the duration of the levy. Each 13 14 enactment shall specify the types of counties authorized to levy; 15 the rate or rates which may be imposed; the maximum length of time the surtax may be imposed, if any; the procedure which must 16 be followed to secure voter approval, if required; the purpose 17

for which the proceeds may be expended; and such other 18 requirements as the Legislature may provide. Taxable transactions 19 20 and administrative procedures shall be as provided in s. 212.054. 21 (8) EMERGENCY FIRE RESCUE SERVICES AND FACILITIES SURTAX.--22 (a) Upon meeting the condition specified in paragraph (c), 23 the governing authority of a county providing emergency fire rescue services may authorize, by ordinance, the levy of a 24 25 discretionary sales surtax of 1 percent as provided in this 26 subsection for emergency fire rescue services and facilities. 27 (b) The ordinance shall be effective if approved by a 28 majority of the electors of the county voting in the referendum. 29 The ballot title and summary shall briefly describe the purposes 30 and uses of the surtax and conform to the requirements of s. 101.161. 31 32 (c) As a condition precedent to holding the referendum authorized by this subsection, the county shall enter into an 33 34 interlocal agreement with the governing body of the municipality or municipalities representing a majority of the population of 35 36 the incorporated area of the county. Such interlocal agreement 37 shall include provisions for improving coordination and efficiencies in service delivery and specify the duration of the 38 39 surtax. 40 1. The interlocal agreement shall specify a distribution 41 formula for dividing the entire proceeds of the surtax among 42 county government and all municipalities and independent special 43 fire districts within the county. Alternatively, the interlocal agreement may provide for the proceeds to be distributed in 44 45 accordance with subparagraph 2. 46 2. If the interlocal agreement does not specify a 47 distribution formula, the proceeds of the surtax shall be Page 2 of 4

53	(d) Upon the surtax taking effect and the initiation of		
54	collections, the county shall reduce the ad valorem tax levy in		
55	its next and subsequent budgets by the estimated amount of		
56	revenue to the county provided by the surtax. A municipality or		
57	independent special fire district shall reduce the ad valorem tax		
58	levy in its next and subsequent budgets by the estimated amount		
59	of revenue provided to that municipality or special district by		
60	the surtax.		
61	Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2008.
