18	refund by the office; amending s. 624.4623, F.S.;
19	prohibiting independent educational institution self-
20	insurance funds from being required to participate in
21	certain guaranty associations created pursuant to state
22	law; providing that such self-insurance funds are not
23	entitled to coverage under such guaranty associations;

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26	Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:
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28	Section 1. Subsection (5) of section 624.4621, Florida
29	Statutes, is amended to read:

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624.4621 Group self-insurance funds.--30 31 (5) A dividend or premium refund of any self-insurer 32 established under this section, otherwise earned, may not be made contingent upon continued membership in the fund, renewal of any 33 34 policy, or the payment of renewal premiums for membership in the 35 fund or on any policy issued by such self-insurer. The board of trustees of a self-insurer may declare any 36 (a) moneys in excess of the amount necessary to fund all obligations 37 38 of the self-insurer as refundable to the members or policyholders of the self-insurer. The board of trustees may distribute such 39 dividends or premium refunds at its discretion, in accordance 40 41 with the agreement establishing the self-insurer and subject to 42 the following limitations: 43 1. The amount of the distribution may not exceed the sum of 44 the total dividends declared and unpaid to policyholders and 45 unassigned funds as recorded on the most recently completed 46 audited financial statements of the self-insurer; 47 2. The payment of the dividend or premium refund may not 48 jeopardize the financial condition of the self-insurer or result 49 in the self-insurer's having a negative unassigned funds balance. 50 (b) No later than 10 days after the payment of a dividend 51 or premium refund, the self-insurer Before making any dividend or 52 premium refund, the group self-insurer shall submit to the office 53 the following information: 54 1.(a) An Audited certified financial statements as of the 55 most recently completed fund year statement. 56 2.(b) An annual evaluation of loss reserves by a qualified 57 independent actuary as of the most recently completed fund year 58 report of financial condition.

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59 (c) A loss reserve review by a qualified actuary. 60 61 If a self-insurance fund does not make or declare a dividend or 62 member distribution payable during a given fund year, the 63 required information listed in subparagraphs (b)1.-2. paragraphs 64 $\frac{(a)-(c)}{(a)}$ shall be submitted annually, no later than 7 months after 65 the end of the group self-insurer's fund year. A request for such 66 dividend or premium refund may not be made before the required 67 information is filed. The written notice to the office request 68 for such dividend or premium refund must include a resolution of 69 the board of trustees of the group self-insurer stating the 70 requesting approval of a specific amount that has been paid to 71 the members or policyholders to be distributed. A dividend, 72 premium refund, or premium discount or credit must not 73 discriminate on the basis of continued coverage or continued 74 membership in the group self-insurer. The office shall review the 75 request and shall issue a decision within 60 days after the 76 filing. Failure to issue a decision within 60 days constitutes an 77 approval of the request. Any dividend or premium refund that 78 approved by the office for distribution which cannot be paid to 79 the applicable member or policyholder or former member or 80 policyholder of the group self-insurer because the former member 81 or policyholder cannot be reasonably located shall become the 82 property of the group self-insurer. 83 Section 2. Subsection (3) is added to section 624.4623, Florida Statutes, to read: 84

85 624.4623 Independent Educational Institution Self-Insurance 86 Funds.--

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87	(3) An independent educational institution self-insurance
88	fund shall not be required to participate in, or entitled to
89	coverage under, the guaranty associations created pursuant to
90	parts II and V of chapter 631.
91	Section 3. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.
