21	training investment assessments from employer contributions under
22	<u>s. 443.131.</u>
23	(2) The trust fund is established for use as a depository
24	for funds to be used for the purposes of the Florida Business and
25	Workforce Competitiveness Program established in s. 445.06.
26	(3) Notwithstanding s. 216.301 and pursuant to s. 216.351,
27	any balance in the trust fund at the end of any fiscal year shall
28	remain in the trust fund at the end of the year and shall be
