8	Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:
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10	Section 1. Subsections (1), (4), and (7) of section
11	250.5206, Florida Statutes, are amended to read:

13	Military Affairs shall establish <u>the</u> <del>a state</del> Family Readiness
14	Program headed by a program director and based on the United
15	States Department of Defense National Guard and Reserve Family
16	Readiness Strategic Plan 2004-2005 initiative.
17	(1) PROGRAM PURPOSEThe purpose of the program <u>is</u> shall
18	<del>be</del> to provide need-based <u>financial</u> assistance to <u>eligible</u>
19	families of servicemembers of the Florida National Guard and
20	United States Reserve Forces, including the Coast Guard Reserves,
21	who are on active duty serving in the Global War on Terrorism and
22	who are federally deployed or participating in state operations
23	for homeland defense, and eligible families of such
24	servicemembers.
25	(4) ELIGIBILITY
26	(a) The following persons are eligible to receive financial
27	assistance from the Family Readiness Program:
28	1. Florida residents who are members of the Florida
29	National Guard and United States Reserve Forces, including the

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30 Coast Guard Reserves, who are on active duty serving in the 31 Global War on Terrorism and who are federally deployed or 32 participating in state operations for homeland defense; and 33 2. Florida residents who are designated as beneficiaries on 34 the United States Department of Defense Form 93, or who are 35 otherwise dependents, of a servicemember eligible under 36 subparagraph 1. and who are family members of such servicemember. 37 (b) An eligible person may request financial assistance 38 from the Family Readiness Program for 120 days following 39 termination of the eligible servicemember's military orders for qualifying service and return to home of record. Eligible 40 41 recipients shall include persons designated as beneficiaries on 42 the United States Department of Defense Form 93, or who are 43 otherwise dependents of eligible servicemembers, and who are 44 residents of the State of Florida. The period of eligibility to 45 request assistance from the fund continues for 120 days following 46 termination of the service member's military orders for 47 qualifying service and return to home of record.

48 (7) ANNUAL REPORT.--The department shall maintain 49 sufficient data to provide an annual report to the Governor and 50 the Legislature on the <u>servicemembers and</u> families served under 51 the program, the types of services provided, and the allocation 52 of funds spent.

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Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2008.

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
