2	A resolution recognizing Korean War Veterans.

4	WHEREAS, on June 25, 1950, along the 38th Parallel, a war
5	began in Korea which would be like no other war in history when
6	the United States of America joined with the United Nations to
7	take a stand against a threat to all democratic nations
8	throughout the world, and
9	WHEREAS, the Korean War is often referred to as the
10	"Forgotten War" due to our country's reluctance to memorialize
11	the violence, valor, and exposure to the elements that soldiers
12	endured at the front lines of the conflict, and
13	WHEREAS, there were 33,741 American military casualties
14	among the 92,134 wounded soldiers, with 4,820 brave men listed as
15	"missing in action" and later declared deceased and 7,245
16	individuals taken as prisoners of war, of whom 2,847 valiant
17	souls gave their lives in prisoner of war camps and only 389 were
18	known to be repatriated after all the American prisoners were
19	purportedly returned, and
20	WHEREAS, the people of the United States of America have
21	honored those veterans who served in that bitter war through the
22	establishment of the Korean War Memorial in Washington, D.C., as
23	well as memorials being established throughout the United States
24	to commemorate the sacrifices of the brave men and women who
25	served, in order that the Korean War never be a forgotten war,

27	WHEREAS, the Korean War Memorial in Southwest Florida will
28	be an enduring testament to democracy and freedom throughout the
29	world and a place of remembrance of the thousands of Americans
