1 Senate Resolution 2 A resolution recognizing Vietnam War Veterans. 3 4 WHEREAS, the Vietnam War has been documented as the longest 5 United States military conflict in history, lasting 30 years, 6 with United States military personnel involvement from 1960 to 7 1975, and 8 WHEREAS, the soldiers of the United States 9th Marine 9 Regiment landed in Da Nang in March 1965 to protect United States air bases in South Vietnam, and direct United States military 10 11 troop involvement commenced in an effort to prevent the collapse 12 of the government of South Vietnam, and WHEREAS, the United States government committed 2.59 million 13 14 Air Force, Navy, Marine, and Army personnel to serve in the 15 Vietnam War over a 10-year period with more than 58,000 brave soldiers giving their lives in combat and more than 300,000 16 17 soldiers wounded, more than half of those receiving very serious 18 injuries, and 19 WHEREAS, the average age of those fighting for democracy and 20 freedom in the Vietnam War was 19 years of age - younger than 21 those who served in World War II and the Korean War, and 22 WHEREAS, the United States government under President 23 Richard M. Nixon initiated United States troop withdrawal in 1969 24 and on January 27, 1973, the United States, South Vietnam, the 25 PRG, and North Vietnam signed the Treaty of Paris, with the final 26 withdrawal of all troops from Vietnam taking place on March 29, 27 1973, and 28 WHEREAS, the Vietnam War Memorial in Washington, D.C. was 29 dedicated in 1982 to commemorate the United States soldiers who
