5	WHEREAS, cancer will strike approximately one out of two men
6	and about one out of every three women in the course of their
7	lives, and
8	WHEREAS, cancer accounts for one out every four deaths, and is
9	the second-leading cause of death in the United States, and
10	WHEREAS, the American Cancer Society estimates that more
11	than 101,920 new cases of cancer in Florida will be diagnosed and
12	more than 41,660 Floridians will die from cancer in 2008, and
13	WHEREAS, many cancers can be prevented by lifestyle changes
14	or cured if detected early and treated promptly, and
15	WHEREAS, as many as one-third of the cancer deaths occurring
16	each year are related to nutrition, physical inactivity, obesity,
17	and other lifestyle factors, and thus might have been prevented,
18	and
19	WHEREAS, almost half of all individuals who continue to
20	smoke may expect to die prematurely from lung cancer or other
21	tobacco-related diseases, and
22	WHEREAS, 30 percent of all cancer deaths and 87 percent of
23	all lung cancer deaths are caused by smoking cigarettes or other
24	tobacco products, and
25	WHEREAS, the 5-year survival rate for all cancers combined
26	is 66 percent, but survival rates may increase even more for
27	certain cancers such as breast, cervical, and colorectal cancers
28	if they are detected and treated early, and
