Section 1. Subsection (8) is added to section 99.012, Florida Statutes, to read:

99.012 Restrictions on individuals qualifying for public office.--

(8) A law enforcement officer is not required to resign his or her law enforcement office upon qualifying as a candidate for public office or election to public office unless the officer is seeking a public office currently held by an officer who has authority to appoint, employ, promote, or otherwise supervise that person and who has qualified as a candidate for reelection to that office. This chapter does not prohibit a subordinate
