15	shall estop the defendant from denying the essential allegations
16	of that offense in any subsequent civil proceeding.
17	(b) An order of restitution under this section does
18	hereunder will not bar any subsequent civil remedy or recovery,
19	but the amount of such restitution <u>actually collected</u> shall be
20	<u>credited</u> set off against any subsequent independent civil <u>award</u>
21	recovery.
22	Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2008.
