An act relating to radio equipment using law enforcement frequencies; amending s. 843.16, F.S.; providing an

exception to prohibition on use of such equipment for specified personnel using personal transportation to and from work; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

- Section 1. Subsection (3) of section 843.16, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:
- 843.16 Unlawful to install or transport radio equipment using assigned frequency of state or law enforcement officers; definitions; exceptions; penalties.--
 - (3) This section does shall not apply to the following:
- $\underline{\text{(a)}}$ Any holder of a valid amateur radio operator or station license issued by the Federal Communications Commission.
- (b) or to Any recognized newspaper or news publication engaged in covering the news on a full-time basis.
- (c) or Any alarm system contractor certified pursuant to part II of chapter 489, operating a central monitoring system.
- (d) Any sworn law enforcement officer or emergency rescue personnel while using personal transportation to and from work.

 Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2008.
