Section 3. Subsection (13) of section 553.36, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

553.36 Definitions. -- The definitions contained in this section govern the construction of this part unless the context otherwise requires.

"Manufactured building" means a closed structure, building assembly, or system of subassemblies, which may include structural, electrical, plumbing, heating, ventilating, or other service systems manufactured in manufacturing facilities for installation or erection as a finished building or as part of a finished building, which shall include, but not be limited to,



residential, commercial, institutional, storage, modular and factory-built buildings, and industrial structures. The term includes buildings not intended for human habitation such as lawn storage buildings and storage sheds manufactured and assembled offsite by a manufacturer certified in conformance with this part. This part does not apply to mobile homes.
