14	emergency medical dispatcher or the emergency medical dispatch

16	medical dispatch protocols are presumed not to have acted
17	negligently regarding any injuries or damages resulting from the
18	use of emergency medical dispatch protocols, if the emergency
19	medical dispatcher or the emergency medical dispatch agency, its
20	agents, or its employees:
21	(a) Properly trained their emergency medical dispatchers in
22	an emergency medical dispatch that is substantially similar to
23	standards set forth by the American Society for Testing and
24	Materials or the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration.
