18	of an act committed outside this state which would be a sexual
19	battery if committed in this state, which results in the victim
20	giving birth to a child.
21	Section 2. Section 794.057, Florida Statutes, is created to

23	794.057 Restitution for sexual batteryIf a child is
24	conceived as the result of a sexual battery, the court may order
25	the defendant to pay restitution to the victim, pursuant to s.
26	775.089, for the monetary expenses related to the support of the
27	child. If restitution is ordered:
28	(1) The court shall give consideration to the child support
29	guideline schedules provided in s. 61.30 when determining the

30	amount of restitution.
31	(2) Payments shall be remitted to the clerk of the court
32	where the conviction was entered and paid by the clerk of the
33	court to the State Disbursement Unit for child support payments

35	distribute the payment in the same manner as a child support
36	payment and without regard to the termination of the obligor's
37	parental rights.
38	(3) The amount may not be reduced due to the offender's
39	inability to pay.
