A bill to be entitled An act relating to the Department of Transportation; requiring the department to conduct a study of alternative highway routes parallel to Interstate 95; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. By December 31, 2008, the Department of Transportation shall complete a study to maximize the use of alternative highway routes, including U.S. 301, for the travel corridor parallel to Interstate 95. The report shall include, but need not be limited to, identification of cost-effective measures that may be implemented to alleviate congestion on Interstate 95 by making other roadways more conducive to long-distance, interstate traffic.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2008.
