7 Section 22. For the 2008-2009 fiscal year, the nonrecurring
8 sum of \$50,000 is appropriated in lump sum from the Records
9 Management Trust Fund to the Department of State, and for the
10 2009-2010 fiscal year, the nonrecurring sum of \$401,000 is
11 appropriated in lump sum from the Records Management Trust Fund
12 to the Department of State for the purposes of carrying out the
13 provisions of this act requiring the implementation of electronic
14 publications. To cover this nonrecurring cost to implement system
15 modifications, the Department of State shall temporarily increase
16 the space rate charge for publication in the Florida
17 Administrative Weekly. After implementation of the required



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18 system changes, the department shall decrease the fee to the
19 2007-2008 fiscal year level. Funds appropriated shall be held in
20 a lump-sum category, contingent on available cash deposited into
21 the trust fund and derived from the fee increase. Funds collected
22 from the fee increase and not expended by June 30, 2009, may be
23 retained in the trust fund to complete the system implementation
24 as appropriated in the 2009-2010 fiscal year.

25 Section 23. For the 2008-2009 fiscal year, the Department
26 of State is authorized one additional full-time equivalent
27 position, salary rate of 16,969, and the recurring sum of \$22,399
28 in salaries and benefits from the Records Management Trust Fund
29 for the purpose of handling administrative and system
30 requirements in carrying out the provisions of this act related
31 to electronic publications.

32 Section 24. Notwithstanding s. 120.55(8)(b), Florida
33 Statutes, on July 1, 2009, the unencumbered balance in the
34 Records Management Trust Fund for fees collected pursuant to
35 chapter 120, Florida Statutes, may not exceed \$300,000 plus any
36 funds collected, but not expended, from the fee increase
37 implemented to fund the provisions of this act. By June 30, 2009,
38 any funds in excess of this amount shall be transferred to the
39 General Revenue Fund. This section expires August 1, 2009.
