9 (1) A student alleged to have committed a serious offense  
10 shall be reported to the law enforcement agency having  
11 jurisdiction over the student's school of attendance. This  
12 requirement may be satisfied by providing notice to the  
13 appropriate school resource officer of the charge of violation  
14 of the code of student conduct and discipline code.
