

18	(2) A person <u>commits</u> is guilty of the unlawful <u>possession</u>
19	wearing of a bulletproof vest when, acting alone or with one or
20	more other persons and while possessing a firearm, he or she
21	commits or attempts to commit any murder, sexual battery,
22	robbery, burglary, arson, aggravated assault, aggravated battery,
23	kidnapping, escape, breaking and entering with intent to commit a
24	felony, criminal gang-related offense under chapter 874,
25	narcotics offense under chapter 893, or aircraft piracy and, in
26	the course of and in furtherance of any such crime, he or she
27	<u>possesses</u> wears a bulletproof vest.
28	(3) Any person who is convicted of a violation of this
29	section <u>commits</u> is guilty of a felony of the third degree,
30	punishable as provided in s. 775.082, s. 775.083, or s. 775.084.
