18	for the use of that machine. The fee or surcharge must be
19	disclosed in compliance with 12 C.F.R., part 205, as amended.
20	(2)(a) Subject to the requirements of subsection (1), an
21	agreement to operate or share an automated teller machine may not
22	prohibit, limit, or restrict the right of the operator or owner
23	of an automated teller machine, as defined in s. 655.960(3), <u>to</u>
24	may charge an access fee or surcharge, not otherwise prohibited
25	under state or federal law, to a customer conducting a
26	transaction using an account from a financial institution, as
27	defined in s. 655.005(1)(h), which is located outside $rac{f of}{f of}$ the
28	United States.

30	prohibit or otherwise limit the ability of an operator or owner
31	of an automated teller machine to voluntarily enter into an
