163.3180 Concurrency.--

9 (12) A development of regional impact may satisfy the 10 transportation concurrency requirements of the local 11 comprehensive plan, the local government's concurrency 12 management system, and s. 380.06 by payment of a proportionate-13 share contribution for local and regionally significant traffic 14 impacts, if:

43	transportation system but is not responsible for the additional
44	cost of reducing or eliminating backlogs. This subsection also
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45	applies to Florida Quality Developments pursuant to s. 380.061
46	and to detailed specific area plans implementing optional sector
47	plans pursuant to s. 163.3245.
48	(16) It is the intent of the Legislature to provide a
49	method by which the impacts of development on transportation
50	facilities can be mitigated by the cooperative efforts of the
51	public and private sectors. The methodology used to calculate
52	proportionate fair-share mitigation under this section shall be
53	as provided for in subsection (12).
54	(i) As used in this subsection, the term "backlog" means a
55	facility or facilities on which the adopted level-of-service
56	standard is exceeded by the existing trips, plus additional
