21 (a) Grant applicants shall be ranked competitively. 22 Preference must be given to applicants who leverage additional 23 private funds and public funds, particularly federal funds designated for the acquisition, construction, or and 24 25 rehabilitation of transitional or permanent housing for homeless 26 persons; , who acquire, build, or rehabilitate the greatest 27 number of units, and who acquire, build, or rehabilitate in catchment areas having the greatest need for housing for the 28 29 homeless relative to the population of the catchment area.

30 (b) Funding for any particular project may not exceed31 \$750,000.

32 (c) Projects must reserve, for a minimum of 10 years, the 33 number of units <u>acquired</u>, constructed, or rehabilitated through 34 homeless housing assistance grant funding to serve persons who 35 are homeless at the time they assume tenancy.

36 (d) No more than two grants may be awarded annually in any 37 given local homeless assistance continuum of care catchment 38 area.

(e) A project may not be funded which is not included inthe local homeless assistance continuum of care plan, as
