23	branch office of the supervisor, any city hall or public library
24	facility, or any other location designated by the supervisor

26	mark, code, indicate on, or otherwise track the voter's precinct
27	for each early voted ballot. In order for a branch office to be
28	used for early voting, it shall be a permanent facility of the

The supervisor may also 31 designate any city hall or permanent public library facility as early voting sites; however, if so designated, the Early voting 32 33 sites must be geographically located so as to provide all voters 34 in the county an equal opportunity to cast a ballot, insofar as 35 is practicable. The Division of Elections of the Department of 36 State shall establish by rule a formula for determining the 37 number of early voting sites in each county. The results or 38 tabulation of votes cast during early voting may not be made 39 before the close of the polls on election day. Results shall be 40 reported by precinct. 41 (d) Early voting shall begin on the 15th day before an

42 election and end on the 2nd day before an election. For purposes 43 of a special election held pursuant to s. 100.101, early voting shall begin on the 8th day before an election and end on the 2nd 44 day before an election. Early voting shall be provided for 12 8 45 46 hours per weekday and 12 & hours in the aggregate each weekend 47 at each site during the applicable periods. Early voting sites 48 shall open no sooner than 7 a.m. and close no later than 7 p.m. on each applicable day. 49
