19	(a) Submits verification from the employing agency or
20	criminal justice selection center that the applicant has
21	successfully completed a comparable basic auxiliary law
22	enforcement training program in another state;
23	(b) Demonstrates proficiency in high-liability areas, as
24	defined by commission rule;
25	(c) Has served as an auxiliary law enforcement officer in
26	another state for at least 1 year, with a maximum 8-year break
27	in service from the separation date of the applicant's most
