19	be distributed quarterly by the Fish and Wildlife Conservation
20	Commission to Southeastern Guide Dogs, Inc., located in
21	Palmetto. Southeastern Guide Dogs, Inc., shall use the
22	contributions to breed, raise, and train guide dogs specifically
23	for the Paws for Patriots program, including in-residence
24	training for veterans who are provided guide dogs by
25	Southeastern Guide Dogs, Inc.
26	Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2009.
