The word "Florida" must appear at the top of the plate, and the words "Bay of Pigs Museum & 25 26 Library" must appear at the bottom of the plate. 27 (b) The license plate annual use fees shall be distributed 28 to the Bay of Pigs Museum and Library to fund its activities,
