Subsections (8) and (12) of section 481.203, 20 Florida Statutes, are amended to read: 21 481.203 Definitions.--As used in this part: 22 "Interior design" means designs, consultations, (8) 23 studies, drawings, specifications, and administration of design 24 construction contracts relating to nonstructural interior 25 elements of a building or structure.
