29 Section 2. Subsection (3) of section 285.061, Florida 30 Statutes, is amended to read:

31 285.061 Transfer of land to United States in trust for
32 Seminole and Miccosukee Indian Tribes.--

33 All the provisions of this chapter, not in conflict (3) 34 with this section, remain in full force and effect. The state 35 reserves both civil and criminal jurisdiction over said 36 reservations, other than Indian reservations of the Miccosukee Tribe of Indians of Florida, in accordance with ss. 285.16 and 37 38 285.165 and applicable federal law. The transfer of lands in trust for the Miccosukee Tribe of Indians of Florida made 39 pursuant to the authority of this section remains subject to all 40 of the rights, easements, and reservations in favor of the South 41 42 Florida Water Management District provided in the transfer.

Section 3. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.
