23	(1) An independent postsecondary educational institution

(e) The institution is a Florida corporation. 37 (3) Beginning January 1, 2010, in order to maintain a 38 39 license by means of accreditation, each licensed institution 40 shall provide the commission with a site report prepared by its 41 accrediting agency which includes a visit to each location 42 licensed in the state. Each institution shall be responsible for 43 requesting periodic site visits and shall file the site report, 44 prepared by the accrediting agency, with the commission. The 45 commission, at its discretion, may request a site visit to be 46 performed by the accrediting agency. 47 (4) (3) Except as provided in subsection (3), the commission 48 may not require an institution granted a license by means of accreditation to submit reports that differ from the reports 49 50 required by its accrediting association, except that each 51 institution must file with the commission an annual audit report

51 institution must file with the commission an annual audit report 52 and follow the commission's requirements for orderly closing, 53 including provisions for trainout or refunds and arranging for 54 the proper disposition of student and institutional records.

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Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2009.

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
