Section 4. Section 381.0203, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

381.0203 Pharmacy services.-

8 (1) The department may contract on a statewide basis for 9 the purchase of drugs, as defined in s. 499.003, <u>for use</u> to be 10 used by state agencies and political subdivisions, and may adopt 11 rules to administer this section.

12 (2) The department may establish and maintain a pharmacy
13 services program <u>that includes</u>, <u>including</u>, but <u>is</u> not limited

14 to: (a) A central pharmacy to support pharmaceutical services 15 provided by the county health departments, including 16 pharmaceutical repackaging, dispensing, and the purchase and 17 distribution of immunizations and other pharmaceuticals. 18 19 (b) Regulation of drugs, cosmetics, and household products 20 pursuant to chapter 499. (c) Consultation to county health departments as required 21 by s. 154.04(1)(c). 22 23 (d) A contraception distribution program which shall be 24 implemented, to the extent resources permit, through the 25 licensed pharmacies of county health departments. A woman who is eligible for participation in the contraceptive distribution 26 27 program is deemed a patient of the county health department. 1. To be eligible for participation in the program a woman 28 29 must: 30 a. Be a client of the department or the Department of Children and Family Services. 31 32 b. Be of childbearing age with undesired fertility. c. Have an income between 150 and 200 percent of the 33 34 federal poverty level. 35 d. Have no Medicaid benefits or applicable health insurance 36 benefits. 37 e. Have had a medical examination by a licensed health care 38 provider within the past 6 months. f. Have a valid prescription for contraceptives that are 39 40 available through the contraceptive distribution program. q. Consent to the release of necessary medical information 41 42 to the county health department.
