20	(qqq) Go Green Florida license plate, \$25.

23	plate, \$25.
24	(ttt) Trinity license plate, \$25.
25	Section 2. Subsections (69), (70), (71), and (72) are added
26	to section 320.08058, Florida Statutes, to read:

28	(69) GO GREEN FLORIDA LICENSE PLATES.—
29	(a) The department shall develop a Go Green Florida license

30	plate as provided in this section. The plate must bear the
31	colors and design approved by the department. The word "Florida"
32	must appear at the top of the plate, and the words "Go Green
33	Florida" must appear at the bottom of the plate. The Go Green
34	Florida emblem or logo must appear on the plate.
35	(b) The requirements of s. 320.08053 must be met before the
36	issuance of the plate.
37	(c) The proceeds from the sale of the plate shall be
38	distributed to the Coalition for Renewable Energy Solutions,
39	Inc. After reimbursement for documented costs expended to
40	establish the plates and for annual auditing costs, the
41	coalition shall use the proceeds of the annual use fees in the
42	following manner:
43	1. A maximum of 5 percent shall be used for administrative
44	costs directly associated with the management and distribution
45	of the proceeds.
46	2. A maximum of 25 percent shall be used for the continuing
47	statewide promotion and marketing of the plate.
