Senate Memorial

A memorial to the Congress of the United States, urging Congress to adopt and submit to the states for ratification an amendment to the Constitution of the United States to provide term limits for United States Senators and Representatives.

WHEREAS, the citizens of Florida have, by an overwhelming majority, expressed their desire that elected officials be subject to limits on their terms of office, and

WHEREAS, the qualifications for election to the Congress of the United States are prescribed in the United States Constitution, and

WHEREAS, in order to carry out the intent of the people of the State of Florida, an amendment to the United States Constitution is required, NOW, THEREFORE,

Be It Resolved by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

That the Congress of the United States is requested to adopt and submit to the states for ratification an amendment to the Constitution of the United States which contains the following provisions:

1. That a person may not serve in the office of United States Representative for more than six terms, except that, with respect to any person who is serving as a United States Representative on the date that a constitutional amendment providing Congressional term limits is ratified or who has served as a United States Representative before that date, such

person may not serve more than one additional term.

- 2. That a person may not serve in the office of United States Senator for more than two terms, except that, with respect to any person who is serving as a United States Senator on the date that a constitutional amendment providing Congressional term limits is ratified or who has served as a United States Senator before that date, such person may not serve more than one additional term.
- 3. That the Congressional term limit amendment submitted to the states for ratification have no time limit within which it must be ratified.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this memorial be dispatched to the President of the United States, to the President of the United States Senate, to the Speaker of the United States House of Representatives, and to each member of the Florida delegation to the United States Congress.
