(b) Seasonal delivery personnel are authorized to use golf 25 carts, modified carts, low-speed vehicles, and utility vehicles 26 as defined in s. 320.01 upon any public road with a speed limit 27 28 of up to 35 miles per hour for the purpose of delivering goods
