30 (b) In addition to the safety equipment required in s. 31 316.212(6) and any more restrictive safety equipment required by 32 the local governmental entity pursuant to s. 316.212(8), such 33 golf carts and utility vehicles must be equipped with sufficient 34 lighting and turn signal equipment.

35 (c) Golf carts and utility vehicles may be operated only 36 on state roads that have a posted speed limit of 30 miles per 37 hour or less.

38 (2) State employees, state park volunteers, and state park 39 visitors are authorized to use golf carts and utility vehicles, 40 as defined in s. 320.01, upon any public roads within the 41 boundaries of state parks managed by the Division of Recreation 42 and Parks of the Department of Environmental Protection, subject 43 to the following conditions:

(a) Golf carts and utility vehicles must comply with theoperational and safety requirements in s. 316.212.
