CS/HB 417 2009

A bill to be entitled

An act relating to novelty lighters; prohibiting the sale or distribution of novelty lighters; providing a definition; providing an exception; providing penalties; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

- Section 1. (1) Novelty lighters may not be sold at retail, given away, or otherwise distributed to anyone in this state.
- (2) As used in this act, the term "novelty lighter" means a mechanical device that uses a flammable gas or liquid or an electrical current to commonly ignite cigarettes, cigars, or pipes and that resembles a cartoon character, animal, gun, watch, musical instrument, vehicle, or toy, or that plays sounds or musical notes or displays flashing lights or other visual effects.
- (3) This act does not apply to lighters manufactured before January 1, 1980.
- (4) A first violation of this section is a misdemeanor of the second degree, punishable as provided in s. 775.082 or s.

 775.083, Florida Statutes. A second or subsequent violation is a misdemeanor of the first degree, punishable as provided in s.

 775.082 or s. 775.083, Florida Statutes.
 - Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2009.
